RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. At no time shall participants in the parade exit or enter a moving vehicle or trailer.
- 2. Remember, this is a lighted Christmas parade, all entries must be adorned with lights. All floats/fire trucks/ ATV and entries MUST BE LIGHTED.
- 3. All Parade entries shall maintain a distance of no closer than 20 feet to the entry in front of them.
- 4. No stopping will be allowed unless the parade is stopped as a unit. No entry shall be allowed to stop to drop off parade participants. All entries must keep the same pace and distance as the entry in front of them.
- 5. Drivers of registered vehicles must be a licensed driver at least 16 years of age.
- 6. Small children should be accompanied by adults when riding on floats.
- 7. Trailers are required to have functional tail lights. Trailers must be securely attached to the towing vehicle.
- 8. At no time shall anyone be seated on the sides or tailgate of a pickup or have arms or legs hanging over the side.
- 9. All motorized vehicles (3-wheelers, 4-wheelers, golf carts, motorcycles, mopeds, lawn mowers, tractors, dune buggies, jeeps, miniature cars, etc.) must be operated by a responsible individual.
- 10. Walkers are required to provide some form of Holiday lighting.
- 11. Please be cautious when throwing candy, trinkets etc. Parade participants shall exercise due care while participating in the event.
- 12. Holiday music is permitted on parade entry.
- 13. All entries must be at the parade staging area, located at the school parking lot, starting at 5:30 p.m. parade day.
- 14. Parade starts at 6:30 p.m.
