Utility Services

The Water, Sewer and Garbage utilities are billed monthly. Meters are read on or around the 20th of the month. Bills are due in full by the 1stth of the following month. Accounts are deemed delinquent and assessed a 10% penalty if payment is not received in the Village Office by the 14th at 2:30 p.m. There is a \$50.00 utility deposit on all utility accounts. The Village accepts cash, checks, online bill pay, credit/debit card (Visa, MC, AmEx, and Discover) and money order payments. A utility payment drop box is located in the alley next to the Village Office for making utility bill payments.

Emergency Information

In a medical or fire emergency, dial 911. Village law enforcement is provided by the Dakota County Sheriff's Office. If you have a non-emergency you may call dispatch at 402-494-7570. If you have a water or sewer issue, call the Village Maintenance at 402-987-4920.

No person, firm or corporation shall erect, construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, improve, remove, convert, or demolish any building, structure, swimming pool, or parking lot in the City or within one mile of the corporate limits of the Village or cause the same to be done without first obtaining a building permit from the Village Clerk. Contact the Village Office for further information & permit applications.

Dogs/Cats

All dogs and cats more than six months of age and animals defined as potentially dangerous animals of any age kept, housed or harbored within the Village shall be registered within ten days after acquisition. Such animals shall be licensed annually on or before the 1st day of May of each year. (Section 2-302 Homer Municipal Code)
